Regrettably, if any of these items are donated, our collection supervisors at the POD will need to ask you to take them away at your expense, as we cannot sell them. Thank you for your understanding.

Where To Deliver Items?

In Term 3 from 16 July, you can leave smaller items such as books and toys in the boxes at the front of the school office. From 1 August, a POD will be available near the Tuckshop for all donations, including larger items.

Storage is quite limited in the POD, so we kindly ask that larger pieces are delivered 1-3 days before Fete Day.
